night.—

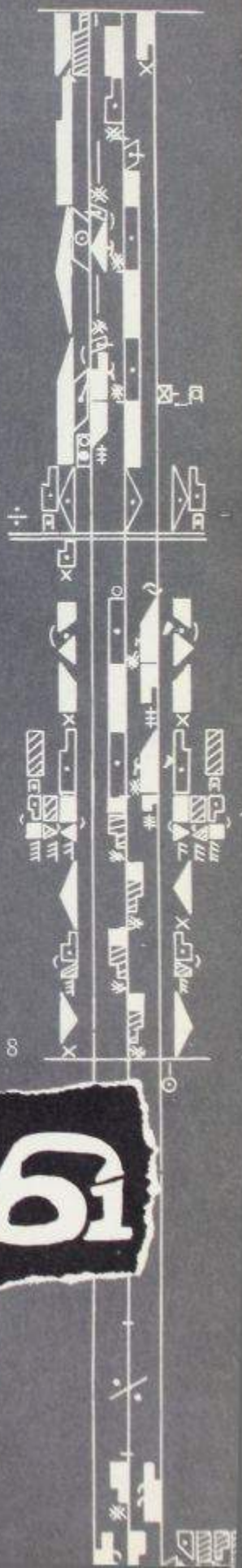
