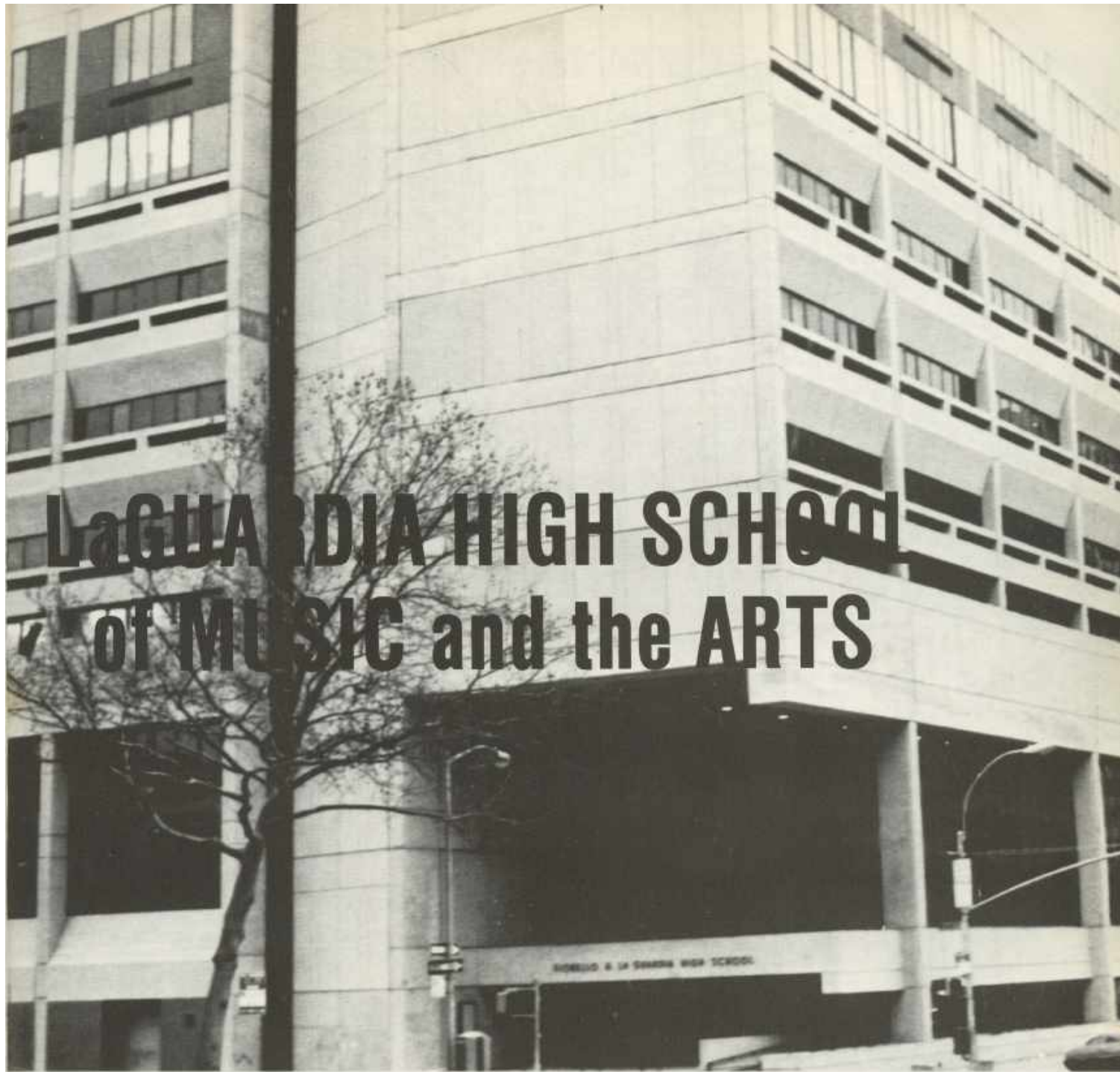

Arts and Music Schools Will Move To Combined Facility Early in '78

The High School of Music and Art and its affiliated High School of Performing Arts now occupying separate facilities uptown and in midtown, will be combined early next year in the building that now houses the Martin Luther King Jr. High School in the Lincoln Center area, school officials said yesterday.

Samuel Polatnick, head of the school system's high school division, said the move of the two nationally known specialized schools, which has been contemplated since the early 1960's, "would enable us to provide imaginative and exciting programs by using some of the extraordinary people associated with music, dance and theatrical activities at Lincoln Center."

However, the expected move opposition from parents at Martin Luther King who don't want to move, as the plan calls for, to the Park West High School nearing completion at 10th Avenue and 50th Street.

"The parents are unanimously negative on the idea," said Joseph Mack, the president of the parents association at Martin Luther King. "Let them move this time and suffer through the problems of starting in a new building with incomplete arts and other facilities."

Building 80% Completed

Mr. Polatnick said the Park West school, being constructed in conjunction with an apartment building by the New York City Educational Construction Fund, was about 85 percent complete and is ready by September, he said. Music and Art will leave the site at Amsterdam Avenue and 135th Street they occupied since its founding in 1951 for a performing-arts school will be a 5-year-old vocational school that it has occupied at 120 West Street since 1949.

The proposal is subject to approval by School Chancellor Irving Anker and the Board of Education, but Mr. Polatnick said he must make a recommendation, he said.

"I like this idea. It would make a very useful contribution to education in the city."

And the principal of the two schools, Richard A. Klein, in a letter to parents last week, spoke of the "good news" that "plans have been announced for our move to the present Lincoln Center site" of the Martin Luther King Jr. High School, at Amsterdam Avenue and 50th Street. Mr. Polatnick said plans had been drawn for the arts schools to occupy a new building, for which a foundation was being dug on West Street when the school construction freeze went into effect last year because of the city's fiscal crisis.

Hugh McLaren Jr., executive director of the division of school buildings at the Board of Education, said yesterday that it would take at least two years to complete the building and that "I can't see that job moving in the next five years." He said the new contemplated move would advance the timetable for the merger of the arts schools by at least seven years.

Mr. Polatnick said the plan called for 2,400 students at Martin Luther King, virtually all of them black and Puerto

Rican, as well as the 1,400 students in the two units of the Food and Maritime Trades High School of 208 West 13th Street would be transferred to the Park West school.

According to building officials at the Board of Education, Martin Luther King will have a capacity for more than 3,700 students—about the same as Park West—when shop facilities now under construction are completed. The total enrollment at Music and Arts 1,875 and Performing Arts (612) is currently just under 2,500. The changes would enable the city system, under pressure from the city to close excess school buildings, to give up a total of four buildings.

Mr. Polatnick indicated that a major stumbling block to the switch was the name for the combined school. The Martin Luther King school, which won a design award for Frost Associates from the New York State Chapter of the American Institute of Architects, displays a large and distinctive exterior sculpture with the name of Martin Luther King Jr., the civil rights leader for which it was named, emblazoned on it boldly.

Mr. Polatnick said the sculpture would either have to be moved to the Park West

Ground Broken for Arts High School

Lincoln Center was filled with singing yesterday morning—not in its concert halls, but on the street at Amsterdam Avenue and 64th Street, where students sang to celebrate the ground breaking for construction of the Fiorello H. La Guardia High School of Music and the Arts.

More than 2,500 students from the High School of Music and Art and the High School for the Performing Arts saw Mrs. Marie La Guardia, widow of the former Mayor, aided by Mayor Lindsay, representatives from the schools' parents association and supporters of the school, broke ground with a gilded shovel.

Plans for the new school, which will combine the two high schools for young people who have an interest in the arts, began 14 years

ago. However, construction was held up because money was not appropriated in the city budget.

Last year, money was returned to the city budget for construction of the building. Richard A. Klein, principal of the High School of Music and Art, said that the building would cost \$32-million and that it should take three years to complete. It will face the Library and Museum of the Performing Arts on Amsterdam Avenue and will have the capacity for 3,000 students.

Mayor Lindsay, speaking to students, alumni and supporters of the construction project who were sitting on folding chairs in the street between 64th and 65th Streets, said that the high school would provide the one element that was missing in the Lincoln Center complex.

Arts students "a much wider range of
electives" and of teachers, as well as
access to honors classes and advance-
placement classes for college, neither
of which the vocational school now has.

A Fear of 'Getting Unfocused'

But cross-pollination is just what
some Performing Arts faculty special-
ists do not want. "Inevitably, if the two
schools are integrated," one said, "our
profession-oriented youngsters are
going to get unfocused in the four years
when concentration is everything."

"It's not too young for them to spe-
cialize — college is too late. Perform-
ing artists are as much born as made,
or at least they're recognizable by the
eighth grade. It's the training they get
in their next growing years that's crucial."

"We don't come out of here stupid —
the academic program is no push-
over," said Jackie Cochrane, a senior
who went to Performing Arts from In-
termediate School 10 in Harlem. He

some day I want to get into a theater
company."

But to Halima Nooradeen, a junior
from Briarwood, Queens, "Academics
are pretty bad here — you'd do better
at M. & A. But I couldn't stand not com-
ing here every morning."

"Neither this building nor Lincoln
Center is the issue," said Jerome
Eskow, head of the Performing Arts
drama department. "I'm interested in
preserving our identity and integrity.
We say, 'Give us half your school day
and we'll train you as a professional.'
Should a young person trade a disciplin-
ed environment for a smorgasbord
environment? We don't discover who
we are through dilettante nibbling."

Responses to Objections

Mr. Klein said he had "tried to calm
the fears" by giving, through a recent
newsletter, the following responses to
the most frequently cited objections:

"The vocational-curriculum pat-
tern for Performing Arts will remain
unchanged." Out of seven daily peri-
ods, ninth- and 10th-graders will con-
tinue to have three studio periods in
dance, music or drama and four aca-

demics. Juniors and seniors will have
four studio periods and three academi-
c.

"PA will be able to hire the same
number of part-time professionals for
its studio courses" — a privilege that
stems from the school's vocational
status. But there are reports that Mr.
Klein faces opposition from the United
Federation of Teachers on this point
of view of continued teacher layoffs.

"PA students will have exclusive
use of studios designed for their train-
ing" — and designed, Mr. Klein notes
by the then-heads of the Perform-
ing Arts dance, drama and music depart-
ments.

"The Performing Arts diploma will
be identified the same as now, from the
Performing Arts division of LaGuardia
High School. 'M & A' is just
anxious to maintain its identity —
has its own reputation."

To the delight of Mr. Klein, some
Music and Art students have already
approached the Performing Arts stu-
dent government about joint efforts, in-
cluding expanded coverage of drama
and dance by their school paper.

High School Is Under Artistic Union

The union of two of New York's finest
public schools, the High School of
Music and Art and the High School of
Performing Arts, was consummated
this week with the opening of the Fiorello
La Guardia High School in
Lincoln Center. Each school will re-
tain its identity but is expected to
benefit from the close presence of
the other and the new theatrical environ-
ment.

Both schools have sent a stream of
talented youngsters into the profes-
sional world. Both have been democ-
ratic in giving rare training to tal-
ented youngsters of every type. Both
have been elitist in holding to the
highest standards of education and
achievement.

Together with other specialized
public schools, these demonstrate
that excellence and equality are com-
patible goals. The opening of Fiorello
La Guardia High School is a cause for
celebration by all New Yorkers.

After years of delay, your class may finally claim the unique distinction of being the first to graduate from this new home.

Despite the hardships you faced as you encountered the physical and emotional discomforts of this move from your familiar surroundings in the old buildings, you persevered as did your predecessors who were involved so many years earlier, and you leave a proud legacy for others to follow.

You have been a wonderful senior class, and your good will and inner strength will serve you well in the years ahead.

I know the entire faculty joins me in wishing you well.
