William Gilbert and Arthur Sullivan viewed the world through glass brighter and clearer than most. With sharp wit, they parodied the customs and prejudices of Victorian England in speech and song. Their works have been perpetually popular because of their pleasant integration of music, drama and dance with optimistic and creative satire. Gilbert and Sullivan did not use their talents to inaugurate any great crusades and did not desire to change existing situations. They wanted to show that the physical existence of an institution does not render it sacred to criticism. For all its sarcasm, Gilbert and Sullivan's work was always sprightly, witty and enjoyable.

As seniors, we have had from three to four years in a separate world--The High School of Performing Arts. We have always been aware of both the serious and humorous aspects of the school. There is a sense of humor unique to a P.A. student--something that raises his flagging spirits, carries him through the perils of competition and examination and rejoices in success.

P.A. has given us an introduction to the glamorous world of the theater--we have rehearsed dramatic scenes next to garbage pails, carried mammoth instruments up interminable stairs, and changed into dance clothes between forkfuls of cottage cheese. The spring fire drills were hazards to traffic, for crosstown drivers were stopped short at the sight of leotard-and-tighted dancers.

Even in our moments of most biting sarcasm, we, like Gilbert and Sullivan, never condemned any of the institutions of the school. We wouldn't want to have missed these years at Performing Arts for all the modern cafeterias and gymnasiums in the world.

Gilbert and Sullivan, renowned for writing caustic parodies of British life, included in the "H.M.S. Pinafore" a song that is often mistaken for Britain's National Anthem. This familiar song is "For He Is An Englishman". We are both the sharpest critics and deepest admirers of our school, and are proud of it.
